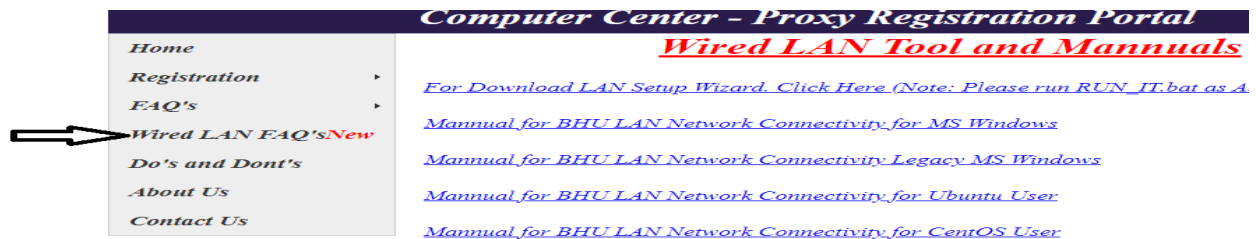




# BHU LAN Network Connectivity User Guide For Windows OS 10/8/8.1/7(SP-1)

## STEP 1: DOWNLOAD(One-time)

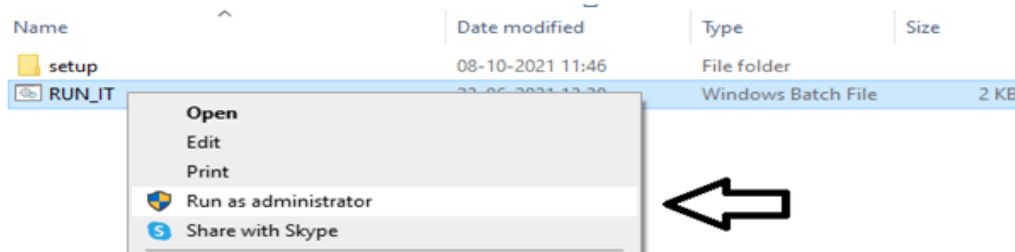


## STEP 2: INSTALL (One-time)

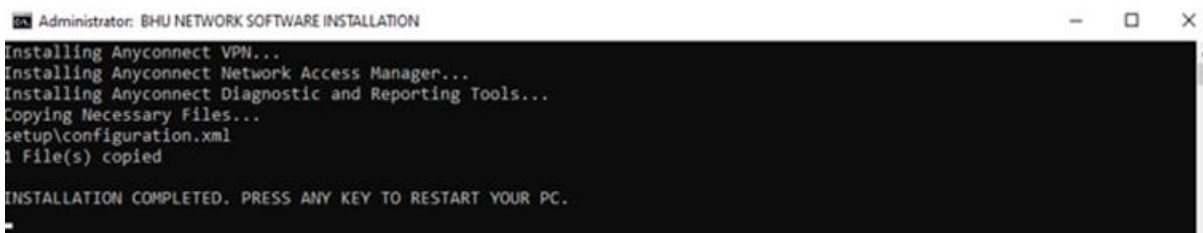
1.Extract the Cisco AnyConnect Client folder.



2. Right click on 'RUN\_IT' file and select 'Run as Administrator'.

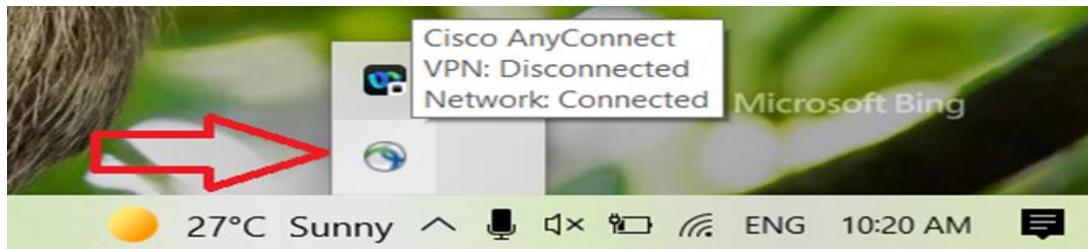


3. Wait for the installation to complete and then restart the PC. **Kindly save your pending work before pressing any key to restart your PC.**



### STEP 3: AUTHENTICATE

1. Open Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client from bottom right corner of taskbar.

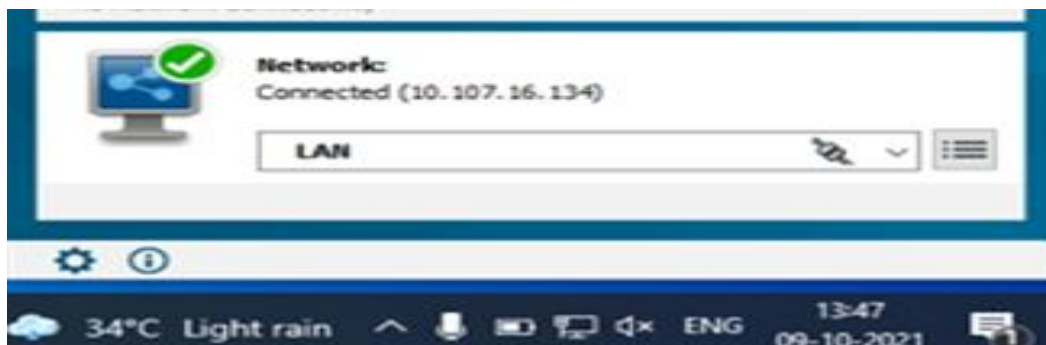


2. Enter your Internet access Username and password (provided by Computer Center) in the field. This is the same username and password as you are using for BHU-WiFi/BHU-WiFi-Secure Connectivity.



### STEP 4: READY TO USE

Once authenticated it will show the IP address (like 10.xx.xx.xxx) of your computer, which confirms that your computer is ready to use internet through wired LAN connection.



### STEP 5: LOGOUT

In order to logout the session users need to sign out their PC by pressing Ctrl+Alt+Delete.

### NOTE:-

If user connecting their WIFI routers with the new LAN connection it will not work.
